Dear Minister Fielding,

We are writing to you in response to your letter dated June 8, 2020 regarding the Order in Council dated May 15, 2020 under the powers of the Emergency Measures Act.

In that letter, you graciously extended provisions for condominium corporations to temporarily suspend meetings and gave allowance for electronic attendance, delivery of notices and voting by other means with effect from March 31, 2020 to September 30, 2020 unless sooner revoked.

We have surveyed our members and, considering their responses and the demographics of condominium corporations in Manitoba, as well as the current Public Health emergency, we are requesting an extension of that Order in Council by another 90 days.

As well, we would urge you to add a provision to the Order that allows general meetings to be conducted within 30 days after the expiration of the period of time covered by the Order in Council so long as notice of the general meeting was provided prior to the expiration of that period of time.

We would be pleased to assist the Manitoba Government in any way including disseminating information to our members and consulting on the areas in need of attention.
